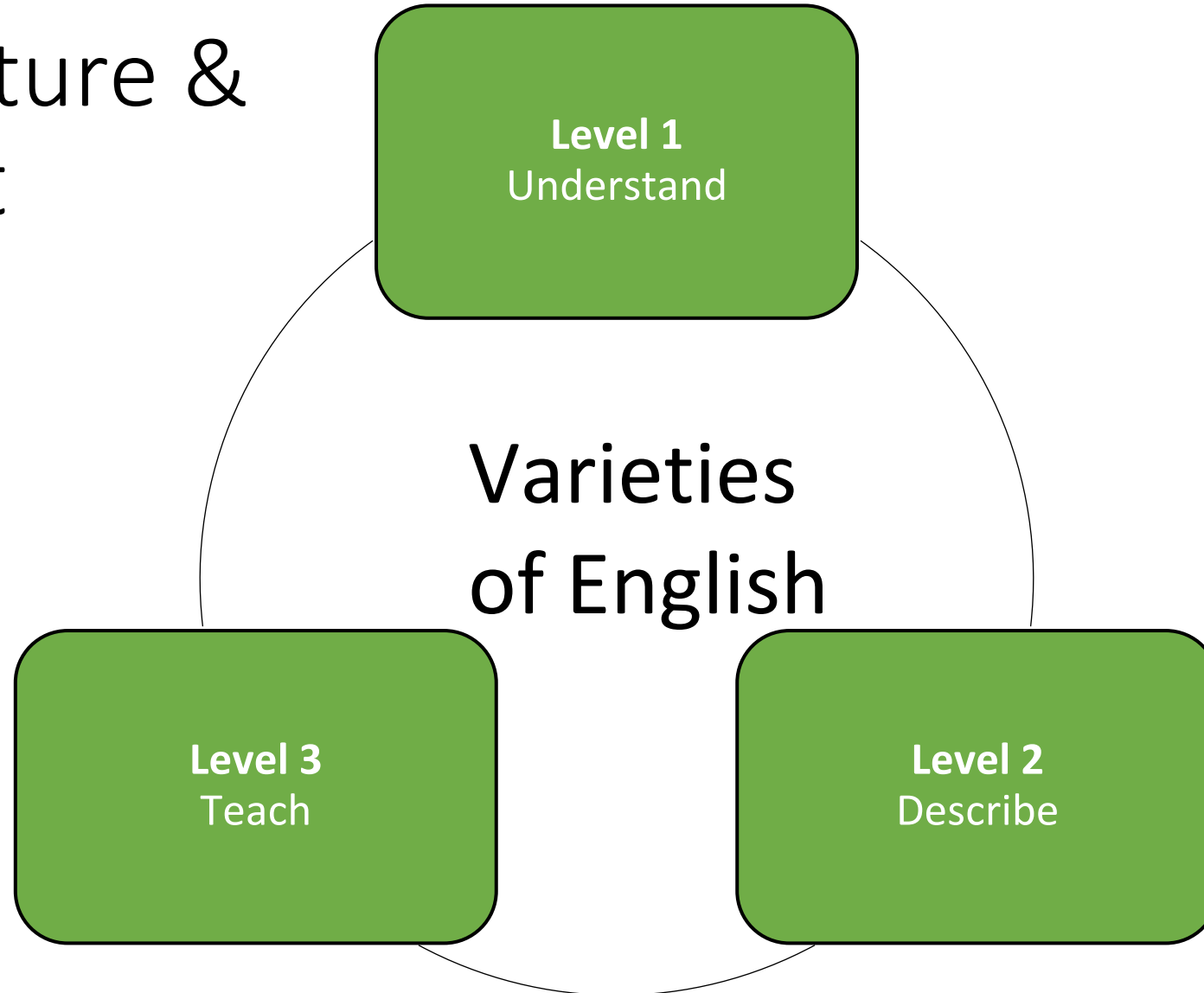


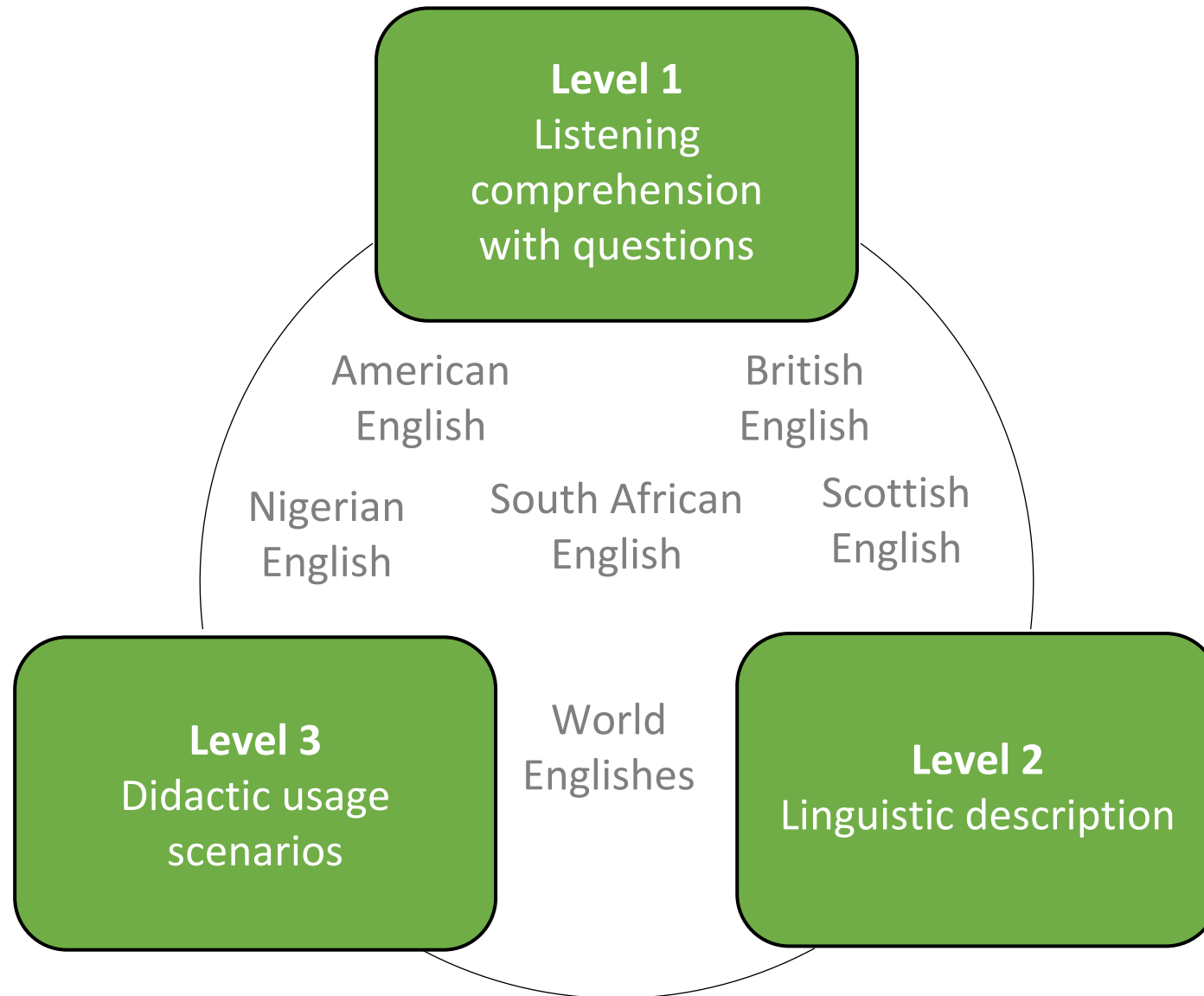
2. Goals

- Start of the project: October 2020
- Development of digital teaching and learning materials for universities on varieties of English
- **Open Educational Resources**



3. Structure & Content







- 2 different types of material:
 - For lecturers (“raw material“, audio/video + transcript, database)
 - For students (H5P units, mix of input and activities)
- Levels: 1 (beginner) – 3 (advanced)
 - List of parameters to determine difficulty (number of speakers, topics, background noise etc.)
 - Used for *Understand*



4. Open Educational Resources

- OER operate on the level of the 5Rs:
 - **Retain** – make, own, and control the resource
 - **Reuse** – use your original, revised or remixed copy
 - **Revise** – edit, adapt, modify your resource
 - **Remix** – combine your original or revised copy of the resource with other existing material to create something new
 - **Redistribute** – share your resource with others
- either in the public domain or under an open license (Creative Commons)



4.1 Why H5P?

- Tool to create interactive content
 - Variety of activities: quizzes, presentations, videos, timelines...
- Integration in Moodle 3.9, compatible with all current LMS (e.g. Ilias)
- Content can be downloaded and easily imported in your own Moodle course
- Why H5P?
 - User-friendly, sustainable, reusable, adaptable



4.2 ORCA.nrw

- **Open Resources Campus** of North Rhine-Westphalia
- Portal as platform and network
- Information and services for e-learning
- For teachers/lecturers and students
- Goal: free teaching/learning material with quality assurance (OER) for universities and exchange of ideas
- Launched on 14th September 2021 > <https://orca.nrw>

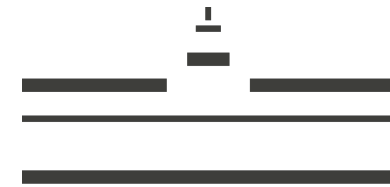
